Bank Credits Soothe Irma's Victims

Sancti Spíritus. — More than 4700 bank credits have been allotted to the victims of hurricane Irma over a month ago after the powerful meteorological phenomenon that swept the North of Cuba.

According to Irma Margarita Martínez, Minister-President of the Banco Central de Cuba the credit applications increase daily and so far it has been allotted more than 13 200 000 pesos.

The minister admitted that it has been a very complex working days to approve the loans in 24 hours, but the bank employees worked rigorously.

She explained: “We had succeeded by means of the human sensitivity that a moment like this demands. We have exceeded every expectations because; even, we have our staff that were also victims of the hurricane”.

In her view, the procedure desks have proved to be a positive experience, and it can be implemented in all procedures from now on.

To date, the people affected by the meteorological phenomenon can apply for credits from 300 pesos, with an interest rate of 2.5% and in a period of up to 15 years.

Sancti Spíritus have approved more than 1 100 loans, equivalent to 3 300 000 pesos, a number that represents the quarter of what our nation has budgeted.

A week after Irma swept Yaguajay coast and when there were still many locations without electricity, every bank employees of Sancti Spíritus were already trained and able to speed up the process in the procedure offices.
