



## Cuban GM Bruzon won 2017 Spice Cup Open

61 players from 19 countries attended the tournament, which was sponsored by the Susan Polgar Foundation and the Webster University

HAVANA, Cuba, Oct 27 (acn) Cuban GM Lazaro Bruzon won undefeated the 2017 Spice Cup Open held in the American city of Saint Louis, where his compatriot Yuniesky Quesada finished second.

The current Cuban national champion signed peace with Peruvian GM Jorge Cori in 29 moves of a Queen's Gambit and reached 6.5 points, thus maintaining the difference in tiebreaking that took him a day before to the first seat.

Bruzon had balance of four wins, five draws and no loss, same performance of Quesada who in the final round also drew with Polish Dariusz Swiercz, the man who ranked third, both tied with the same amount of the leader. 61 players from 19 countries attended the tournament, which was sponsored by the Susan Polgar Foundation and the Webster University.
